Dr. Dimosthenis (Denis) Sarigiannis the Director of the Environment Laboratory at Aristotle University where he leads multiple international research projects on environment and health risk/impact assessment. He has been active in the implementation of the European Union's REACH chemicals safety policy initiative.

Dr. Sarigiannis will introduce an integrated concept called HEALS (health and environment-wide associations via large population surveys), which brings together a complete array of novel technologies, data analysis algorithms and modeling tools into a knowledge management system that supports efficiently exposome studies. The lessons learned will be translated into scientific advice towards the development of protocols and guidelines for the setting up of a larger European environment and health examination survey.
